The government has announced that from Monday June 1st, the limit of people attending a place of worship will be increased to 50.

However, to comply with distancing rules, and by Fr Abmar's calculations, we are able to seat 47 people (including children) in our pews. Please sit where there is no ribbon on the pew.

For the time being, there will be no singing or Procession of the Gifts and no personal contact during the Sign of Peace. No collection will be taken up, but baskets are placed near the piano where you may leave your offering.

Holy Hour and Anointing Mass are suspended until further notice.

If you are able to help with disinfecting the church after Mass, please let the priest know.

*As restrictions are eased, we must all remember to follow the rules, in order to keep one another safe.*

*It is vital that people who are unwell stay at home.*

For those unable to attend the church, at 6am each Sunday Channel 10 televises **Mass for You at Home**.

**The time for Thursday Mass has been changed to 5.40pm.**

**Mass at Whiddon** (formerly Fairview) has not yet resumed. If a resident wants to receive Communion, they (or a family member) needs to speak with Whiddon staff to arrange a pastoral visit.

### ADIG Distribution to Parishes

We have received a deposit of \$42,899 from ADIG, their annual contribution to our parish. This year, ADIG has distributed a total of \$630,000 to the parishes in our Diocese, and another \$2.6 million to the Diocese. We thank ADIG for this generous contribution, and we also thank all parishioners who support ADIG, making this distribution possible.
